Web Site Success Starts with Planning and Preparation

Statistics show that nearly one million new web sites are launched in the U.S. every year. Having a web address and online presence has become as common place, and expected, as having a logo and business card. Business-to-business and business-to-consumer marketing places a great demand, as well as dependence, on having a domain name (url or web address), company email address and web site. Why? Whether you choose to design the web site yourself or hire a web designer, recognizing the value in web site planning cannot be overstated. Adequate preparation on the frontend will save you time, money and frustration down the road. eye ON
