Things you should know BEFORE . . .

Doing Business with the City

Does your business offer products or services the City of Leander may be interested in purchasing? Does your business qualify for HUB certification? To answer both of these questions visit the state's web site at http://www.window.state.tx.us/ and review its section on State Purchasing.

If your business can qualify as a historically under utilized business (HUB) consider becoming certified and adding your name to Leander's list of HUB vendors. By law, the City of Leander is required to contact at least two HUB certified vendors (if available) for all purchases ranging from \$3,000 to \$50,000.

The State of Texas offers free HUB certification for businesses that meet their requirements. Certification is valid for four years and can open doors for you to do business with city, county and state government agencies in Texas.

Art, Science and Relationship Building Leads to Leander

Site selection for retail, manufacturing and other enterprise companies is time-consuming and expensive. Because of this companies and communities must be prepared. The process is undertaken with industrial, commercial, retail and residential development. Each sector has unique site selection criteria involving location, transportation, labor, utilities, education and quality of life (political, safety, recreation, etc.) factors.

Lowe's (located at the corner of US Hwy 183 and Crystal Falls Pkwy) is an excellent example of how communication, patience, persistence and relationships led to a successful site selection process. Leander was introduced to Lowe's by a developer in early 2005. During the International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC) Annual Convention in May 2005. several City officials visited with representatives from Lowe's along with the developer. Over the next two years many developer visits, numerous site, infrastructure and finance discussions occurred along with on-going follow-up. In Sept. 2007 Lowe's began construction of 170,000 square foot facility. Development 2000, the City of Leander and their economic development allies created an environment that will lead to the development of a 400,000 square foot facility on 41 acres by December 2008. So after almost 48 months of "communication" the public and private sectors created an environment that will lead to the creation of more than 400 jobs, an investment of more than \$40 million and sales taxes of over \$800,000 annually for Leander.


